Name of School District

The School District shall be known by its official and incorporated title of:

SALMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 291

The Salmon School District No. 291, hereinafter designated as the "District", shall consist of that geographic area described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Salmon River between Custer County and Lemhi County, which is approximately the Southeast corner of Section 23, T16N R20E EBM, thence running westerly along the line between Lemhi and Custer Counties to a point on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River to a point of intersection of the Middle Fork and Salmon River to a point on Horse Creek, thence northerly along the lines between Lemhi and Idaho Counties, thence following the line between Ravalli County and Lemhi County to a point on the Continental Divide between Idaho and Montana, which is approximately a point known as Gibbonsville Pass, thence southwesterly along the Divide between Montana and Idaho, to a point at the head waters of Kinney Creek, thence westerly down Kinney Creek, to a point which is the Northeast Corner of Section 31, T20N R24E EBM, thence South approximately 1/2 mile to the E1/4 Corner of Section 31, thence west to the W1/4 Corner of Section 31 in T19N R24E, thence west along the lines between Townships 18 and 19 to a point known as the Divide of the Lemhi Range, thence Southerly along the Divide to a point at the head waters of Cow Creek to the place of beginning on the boundary line between Lemhi County and Custer County.

Legal Status and Operation

The Board of Trustees of the Salmon School District #291 is the governmental entity established by the State of Idaho to plan and direct all aspects of the District's operations to the end that students shall have ample opportunity to achieve their individual and collective learning needs and to provide a thorough system of education.

The District in its corporate capacity may sue and be sued and may acquire, hold, and convey real and personal property necessary to its establishment, extension and existence. The District shall have authority to issue negotiable coupon bonds and incur such other debt, in the amounts and manner, as prescribed by law.

The policies of the Board define the organization of the Board and the manner of conducting its official business. The Board's operating policies are those that the Board adopts from time to time to facilitate the performance of its responsibilities.
