

Maximum Drive Time

To promote the safety of students riding in school buses, the Salmon School District is implementing this policy concerning bus driver maximum drive time. It is the policy of the District that bus drivers shall adhere to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations. Currently those regulations provide for a maximum of 10 consecutive hours of actual driving time, or 15 hours of on duty time following 8 consecutive hours off duty. Drivers may not exceed 60 hours on duty time over 7 days.

Drivers shall use FMCSA over-the-road hours-of-service trip logs, a trip agenda, or other trip documentation validating applicable driving hours on all out-of-district trips in excess of one-hundred (100) miles.
